Abstract:

There is in current brain science a shift towards 'contextual' models, both in terms of concrete brain imaging experiments and in terms of general theories of brain function. This is an important move, as it it opens new avenues in how one thinks about, what brains are up to, and thereby also in how consciousness and the brain may be linked. In this talk, I will present cases of this development and discuss how that may affect our understanding of how brains get involved in communication.
