



EuroDEEP Reimbursment rules for the WCMB conference

Meals are foreseen by ESF directly for the EuroDEEP meeting day.

As agreed by the Scientific Committee: young participants (PhDs and young postdocs) will be fully reimbursed, and depending on the available budget, other EuroDEEP participants will be able to claim their travel expenses.
