- Analysis of situation of researchers in different European countries
 - Social situation, scientific visa
 - Contribution by ministries
 - Annual report replacing the report by Steering Group on Human Resources and Mobility
 - First results to appear in spring 2012
- ⇒ Report by Peter Witten (EC) to EARCD in plenary meeting May/June 2012
- ⇒ Report by Hans to EARCD Steering Committee in February 2012



Policy statement – results of 1st brainstorming

- Link to Innovation Union, mode II
- Is intersectoral mobility equally important to all ROs?
- How to enable interdisciplinary research?
- How to facilitate intersectoral/-disciplinary mobility?
 - Combined part-time positions
 - Industrial doctorates
 - Assistant prof II
 - SBR: strategic basic research
- How to recognise intersectoral/-disciplinary mobility?
 - Adapting profiles of researchers looked for
 - Instruments to acknowledge different profiles

 - Recognition of individual careers
 - Explore MOs' current & future policies, incl. issues at stake
- Topics
 - Acknowledgement of different forms mobility & individual profiles
 - Appropriate assessment tools
 - Different formats of peer review: interactive, rebuttal systems
 - Composition of panels
- Next step: design workshop programme on 8th Feb.
