MO Forum main recommendations

- FWF Mission Statement comprises SiS activities a moral standard
 - Own SiS Mission Statement: Not necessary
 - Common Agreement like the High Level Committee: Not useful
 - High Level Committee: Not necessary
 - Exchange of experiences and best practices: Very useful
 - Indicators and evaluation for SiS actions: Exaggerated approach
- Better Science in Society practices are needed: Yes
 - Different recommendations for RPOs and RFOs: Makes sense
 - Infrastructures: part of best practice issue
- Scientists and institutions should be funded and rewarded:
 - Intrinsic vs. extrinsic (motivation): Serious doubts!
 - Evaluation methods / indicators: Objections!

Suggested Interview Questions

Opinion on priorities and recommendations:

SiS is an important issue and there are (very good) reasons for doing it. Nevertheless, tribute should be paid to the existing international differences, the different traditions which have to be faced and the different dynamics which can be observed

'Common Agreement' and the 'High Level Committee'

No, neither a 'Common Agreement' nor a High Level Committee makes sense. It does make sense, to establish a Forum for defining and exchanging best practice examples, to establish a methodology to check the scalability and transferability of SiS formats, etc. There might be a value added if best practice cases are labeled as such

Follow up of the recommendations / structure, system, funding?

Yes, we have an adequate structure. We also have legal instructions paving the way for allocating funds for SiS activities
