

- Published in 2009
- > 10 Actions:

- 2. promote European research careers
- develop scientific foresight for joint strategy
- 4. create a European Grant Union
- 5. address **peer review** of proposals
- 6. develop common approaches to ex-post evaluation
- create ERA Connect and Regional Clusters of Excellence
- 8. develop shared funding and exploitation of **research infrastructure**
- 9. implement common policy on **Open Access**
- 10. connect European research to the world
