

Aim

Network of Member Organisation aware of science interactions with society, aiming to: limprove and introduce different series of practices of engagement of SiS relationships, limprove places/interfaces for dialogue.

Objectives

Making the bridge from public understanding to public engagement by:

□Analysing and mapping practices from MOs

□ Promoting science at the cultural level by diffusing the "scientific culture" in society

Raising awareness of the scientific community on the need for dialogue by giving:

incentives, support, training, accountability (measuring impact)

□Developing 'listening' practices to other stakeholders
