





### Q2A – Is the issue of science-society relationship part of your organisation's overall mission or strategy?








### Q4 – Importance of organisation's relationship with the following publics and partners






### Q4 – Fluency of organisation's relationship with the following publics and partners



Q5 – Does your organisation have a strategic plan or guidelines on improvement of science-society relationship?





### Q5C – Does your organisation have a dedicated structure to science-society relationship?






## Q5C – What resources does your organisation use in financing science-society engagement projects?







