Roger Bouillon is Professor (emeritus since 2010) in endocrinology (internal medicine) at the University and University Hospital of the Catholic University of Leuven (KU Leuven) in Belgium. He is a member of the Royal Academy of Medicine (Belgium) and a Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians (London). He was a founding member and later President of the European Board of Endocrinology (UEMS 1988-2002). He is a member of several European Science Foundation Committees (Core Group member of the European Medical Research Councils (EMRC)) and Board member of the European Space Agency Life Science working group. He is the immediate past-president of the International Bone and Mineral Society (2011-2013) and is co-organiser of the vitamin D workshop. He was vice-president for research of the University of Leuven from 1995-2005.

Roger Bouillon is co-author of more than 500 peer reviewed articles that generated about 20,000 ISI citations and an H-index of 82. The main topics of his research deal with various aspects of bone and calcium homeostasis and this spans the spectrum of basic, translational and clinical research. Vitamin D is a major research focus throughout his scientific career.
